Attkisson Leaves CBS Due to 'Liberal Bias'

“CBS News investigative correspondent Sharyl Attkisson has reached an agreement to resign from CBS...**Attkisson, who has been with CBS News for two decades, had grown frustrated with what she saw as the network's liberal bias, an outsize influence by the network's corporate partners and a lack of dedication to investigative reporting...She increasingly felt that her work was no longer supported and that it was a struggle to get her reporting on air...**

The bulk of Attkisson's work since 2009 has focused on the failures or perceived failures of the Obama administration, including its failed green-energy investments and the attack in Benghazi, though she has reported on several Republican failures as well.

Others have suggested that CBS News itself was politically biased: 'It's no secret that Sharyl has been unhappy about CBS's lack of interest in investigative reporting, especially when it comes to stories about the Obama administration,' a source close to Attkisson said.”

123 Days Since ABC *Nightline* Covered Obamacare
